What is “worship”?

BIG IDEA: Intentionally worshipping God resets our souls to him—his perspectives and priorities. Is that why? No. It is a consistent by-product.

Worship, v. intentionally expressing extravagant love, honor, praise, reverence and submission to God because he is worthy of it.

“Lift up your hands in the holy place and bless the LORD!” **Psalm 134:2** CSB

“No one is to appear before me empty-handed.”
Exodus 23:15

1. Worship intentionally _____ you to God.
It is not about you. It’s about him.

“My soul, bless the LORD, and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

My soul, bless the LORD, and do not forget all his benefits...” **Psalm 103:1-2** CSB

2. Worship _____ you to Who God Is—and the Way Things Truly Are.

Revelation 4:2-6, 5:11-14

“In a loud voice they were saying: “Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!”

Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: “To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!” **Revelation 5:11–14**
