HOW SOWING AND REAPING WORKS

February 23, 2014 Galatians 6:7-10 by Bob Branch The Secret of the Harvest, Part 1

MAIN IDEA: To illuminate 5 dynamics of sowing and reaping—how it works—in order to help us settle into the process, and/or make serious course-corrections.

"Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows." **Galatians 6:7**

- We are prone to deception in this.
- God cannot be mocked... we won't get away with it.
- Undeniable truth: Whatever you plant will produce a crop.

1. No seeds sown, no HARVEST.

"... at the proper time we will <u>reap a harvest</u> if we do not give up." **Galatians 6:9**

If you want something good, significant, positive to grow, you must plant for it.

2. Seeds produce after their OWN KIND.

Then God said, "Every seed will produce <u>more of its own</u> <u>kind</u> of plant." **Genesis 1:11** NCV

3. Seeds do not produce fruit <u>IMMEDIATELY</u>, it takes time.

"And let us not grow weary of doing good, for <u>in due</u> <u>season we will reap</u>, if we do not give up." **Galatians 6:9** ESV (1 Corinthians 3:6)

4. Seeds are an investment in <u>FUTURE</u> fruit, and <u>MORE</u> fruit.

"Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown." **Matthew 13:8**

"And Isaac sowed in that land and <u>reaped in the same</u> <u>year a hundredfold</u>. The LORD blessed him" **Genesis 26:12** ESV

5. Seed sowing is an intentional <u>CHOICE</u>, not a feeling.

"So let's <u>not get tired of doing what is good</u>. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing <u>if we don't</u> <u>give up</u>." **Galatians 6:9** NLT
