What is Eternal Life?

MAIN IDEA: Whatever comes after this life, and however life can be restored and enriched here, the key is <u>Jesus himself</u> and relationship with him.

Eternal life...

Coming age of God's reign... Initiated by Messiah, on the last day, with physical resurrection of dead into a restorednew creation, with God's Spirit poured out

- Restored (new) creation, God reigning as king, setting all things right on earth, spirit poured out (Amos 9; Joel 2)
- Heaven (God's realm) in harmony with earth (Gen. 1-2)
- Messiah would come and inaugurate new/eternal age (Is. 53:10)
- Dead raised (resurrection) at last day (Ez. 37:12f; Dan. 12:13)... physical body out of tombs into restored creation on earth.

"God loved the world with so much love that he gave his son so that everyone who believes in him should not be lost <u>but</u> <u>should share in the life of God's new age</u>." **John 3:16** NTW

1. Eternal Life is JESUS HIMSELF.

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." **John 14:6** "You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life. But the Scriptures point to me! Yet you refuse to come to me to receive this life." **John 5:39-40** NLT

2. It is <u>RESTORED RELATIONSHIP</u> with God
