<u>MAIN IDEA</u>: Today I want to explore the concept of biblical oneness as one of the most transforming and powerful things on the earth. <u>Biblical Oneness is powerful and transforming</u>.

"they become one flesh." Genesis 2:24 (see 11:6)

"united as one man." Judges 20:11 (Ezra 3:1; Neh. 8:1)

"...that they may be one <u>as we are one</u>." John 17:11 (10:16, 30)

"Live in harmony with one another." Romans 12:16

"to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth." **Ephesians 1:10** ESV

"For Christ himself has brought peace to us. <u>He united Jews</u> and <u>Gentiles into one people</u> when, in his own body on the cross, he broke down the wall of hostility that separated us. He did this by ending the system of law with its commandments and regulations. <u>He made peace between Jews and Gentiles</u> by creating in himself one new people from the two groups. <u>Together as one body</u>..." **Ephesians 2:14-16** NLT (4:4-6)

WHY IS IT SO IMPORTANT?

1. Oneness is <u>ULTIMATE</u> to God.

"Make every effort to <u>keep the unity of the Spirit</u> through the bond of peace." **Ephesians 4:3** (Rom. 12:18; 2 Cor. 5:18-21)

2. Oneness is a <u>CONDUIT</u> for the kingdom of heaven.

"<u>All the believers were one in heart and mind</u>... there were no needy persons among them." **Acts 4:32–35**

3. Oneness is the <u>EVIDENCE</u> of the kingdom come.

John 13:35

Acts 2:42-47

4. Oneness is powerful in <u>REVEALING JESUS</u>, his kingdom, love and salvation.

"...that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us <u>so that the world may</u> <u>believe</u> that you have sent me... I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. <u>Then the world will</u> <u>know that you sent me and have loved them</u> even as you have loved me." **John 17:21, 23**

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR US IN PRACTICE?

- ¹ **Oneness is an assault on our <u>fierce individuality</u>**. Change worldview, the way we think. ^(Heb. 10:25)
- ² Oneness means we give up something of ourselves to be part of something greater, and it is totally worth it. ^(Acts 4:35f)
- ³ Oneness can be so powerful that <u>the enemy will do anything</u> <u>to stop it</u>. ^(Eph. 4:26-27)
- ⁴ Oneness means God will consistently call us to <u>take</u> <u>practical steps further into community</u>.

Oneness with your spouse... Oneness in our families.

Oneness in involvement in a local church.

Join a group and connect

Get involved in serving together

Get an **accountability** partner, confess your sins

Give something valuable to you to someone in need.

Start seeing others as intrinsically valuable.

Repent of bitterness, resentment & unforgiveness

Be **reconciled**, humble yourself, apologize

Adopt a **no-tattling policy**, preserve unity, redirect...

Watch how you **talk** about others.

Invite **someone new over**, and make friends.

Commit to not missing church each week.

Come to serve and minister to others.
