## **TEACH YOUR CHILDREN WELL**

September 16 2012 Ephesians 6:1-4 by Bob Branch Living Out Our Inheritance In Christ, Part 29

**MAIN IDEA**: When Jesus comes into someone's life there are sweeping changes that follow. It infects who we are *personally...* who we are as a *husband* or *wife...* who we are as *parents...* who we are as *kids*.

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. **Ephesians 6:1-4** 

## In the Lord...

1. Obey means to LISTEN QUICKLY to and YIELD.

(Exodus 20:12) Honor deals with the heart, with is the action.

2. Obeying <u>UNLEASHES</u> God's promised blessing on your life, as well as a long life.

If someone curses their father or mother, their lamp will be snuffed out in pitch darkness. **Proverbs 20:20** 

**3.** Use strategy, <u>RESTRAINT</u> and understand what you are creating with your actions and words.

Fathers, do not <u>embitter</u> your children, or they will become discouraged. **Colossians 3:21** 

React vs. Respond

Willful defiance vs. Childish irresponsibility

## 4. To train involves <u>SHAPING</u> your children into responsible people.

Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it. **Proverbs 22:6** ESV

- Shaping involves consequences & discipline.
- Shaping involves structure, boundaries and rules.
- Shaping involves care, attention and affection.

## 5. Teach them GOD'S WAYS, to know Him & follow Him.

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. <a href="Impress them on your children">Impress them on your children</a>. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 6:4-7

And he will <u>turn the hearts</u> of fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers... **Malachi 4:6** ESV

Children will invariably talk, eat, walk, think, respond, and act like their parents. Give them a target to shoot at. Give them a goal to work toward. Give them a pattern that they can see clearly, and you give them something that gold and silver cannot buy. **Billy Graham**
