BOLD PRAYER

June 16, 2013 Luke 11:5-13 by Bob Branch Connecting With God Thru Prayer, Part 9

MAIN IDEA: God invites us into an interactive lifestyle of bold asking and receiving as his means of expressing his generosity and love.

... yet <u>because of your shameless audacity</u> he will surely get up and give you as much as you need. **Luke 11:5-8**

1. Jesus is teaching them/us that effective prayer has a kind of <u>SHAMELESS BOLDNESS</u> and <u>AUDACITY</u>.

"<u>O woman, great is your faith</u>! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly. **Matthew 15:28** ESV (15:22-28; Lk. 7:24-30)

A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "<u>Lord,</u> <u>if you are willing, you can make me clean</u>." Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy. **Mt. 8:2-3**

Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak. She said to herself, "<u>If I only touch his cloak, I will be</u> <u>healed</u>." Jesus turned and saw her. "Take heart, daughter," he said, "<u>your faith has healed you.</u>" And the woman was healed at that moment. **Matthew 9:20-22**

⁹ "So I say to you: **Ask** and it will be given to you; **seek** and you will find; **knock** and the door will be opened to you. ¹⁰ For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. **Luke 11:9-10**

2. God invites us into a <u>HABITUAL LIFESTYLE</u> of asking, and a commitment to faith-filled <u>PERSISTENCE</u>.

Lifestyle:

Persistence:

ASK: Make requests of God, interactively

Philippians 4:6 (Luke 18:1-8; Esther 4-5)

SEEK: *To search for, try to find*—His kingdom, will, counsel, perspective, empowering, release, justice for others, the lost.

"Now devote your heart and soul to <u>seeking</u> the LORD your God." **1 Chronicles 22:19** ^(Is. 55:6; Jer. 29:13; Acts 17:27)

"<u>I sought the LORD</u>, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears." **Psalm 34:4** (Heb. 11:6)

"But <u>seek first his kingdom and his righteousness</u>, and all these things will be given to you as well." **Matthew 6:33**

KNOCK: Something needs to be opened. A heart, mind, family, way, mission field, neighborhood.

"they gathered the church together and reported all that God had done through them and <u>how he had opened a</u> <u>door of faith</u> to the Gentiles." **Acts 14:27** (Acts 16:25-26)

"Pray for us, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains." **Colossians 4:3** (1 Cor. 16:9; 2 Cor. 2:12)

¹¹ "Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? ¹² Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? ¹³ If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, <u>how much more will your Father in</u> <u>heaven give the Holy Spirit</u> to those who ask him!" **Luke 11:5-13**

3. The invitation to ask, seek and knock is built of God's <u>GOODNESS</u> and <u>GENEROSITY</u>.

"If you need wisdom, <u>ask our generous God</u>, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking." **James 1:5** NLT

"And we know that in all things <u>God works for the good</u> of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." **Romans 8:28** (1 Chronicles 16:34; Rom. 8:31-32)

"And I am sure of this, that <u>he who began a good work in you</u> will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ." **Phil. 1:6**
