#### THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER

March 30, 2014 Matthew 13:1-23 by Ben Skeat

**Main Idea:** Gods truth has been liberally and deliberately sown into our lives, but it will only find a home and bear fruit in a certain type of person.

"the seed"=Gods word, Gods truth, the message of the kingdom when it is proclaimed, taught, heard, read, discussed, thought about etc....

God's truth has a growing nature where it takes root. (Matt 16:18)

God is not short of seed & it's being very liberally sown (Prov 1:20)

Gods truth is sown in expectation of a harvest. (John 15:16)

Gods word has a multiplying effect where it takes root (Acts 12:24)

### Four basic types of "soil" (and the seed is always the same)

- Unreceptive/Uncomprehending: "Hmmm...Shoes, with zippers"
- <u>Enthusiastic but shallow:</u> The window dressing changes frequently, but the stock in the storeroom remains the same.
- <u>Distracted/Deceived:</u> Busy partaking of and sharing their societies values
- *Understanding/Perceptive*: The only soil that produces a harvest

## 1) Good soil is always formed at the hand of the \_\_\_\_\_

Soil doesn't become good by itself, something from the outside has to change it.

Jesus changes us as we come to know him. His disciples were changed as they:

- Learned from Him (...take my yoke upon you and learn from me...Matt 11:29)
- Imitated Him (Follow Gods example...Eph 5:1)
- Fellowshipped with Him (Abide in me, and I in you...John 15:4)
- Submitted to Him (*To whom else shall we go?...John 6:46*)

Relationship with Jesus must be our focus. Nothing else can change us in the way we need to be changed.

# 2) The soil of our hearts is \_\_\_\_\_as we seek understanding

And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power...to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, (Eph 3:17b-18)

...Though it cost all you have, get understanding (Prov 4:7b)

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God... (James 1:5)

The big question is: Are you a learner or do you think you have it all figured out?

## 3) The soil of our hearts is refreshed and given life we look for Gods hand at work

... our knowledge of men can no longer be based on their outward lives ... (2 Cor 5:16 PHILLIPS)

...People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart (1 Sam 16:7)

When all kinds of trials and temptations crowd into your lives my brothers, don't resent them as intruders, but welcome them as friends!...(James 1:2-3 PHILLIPS)

Submit to understanding Gods ways, and then be on the lookout for what He is up to.

### 4) Gods truth puts down roots in a \_\_\_\_\_soft heart

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience (Col. 3:12)

...go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' Matt 9:13

...the proof of God's amazing love is this: that it was while we were sinners that Christ died for us. (Rom 5:8 PHILLIPS)

We love, because he first loved us (1 John 4:19)

...what is the point of calling me, 'Lord, Lord', without doing what I tell you to do? (Luke 6:46 PHILLIPS).

Blind spot for many of us, but a heart that is soft is a place where Gods word will put down deep roots and produce an amazing harvest.
