MAIN IDEA: "If you start scratching at whatever struggle you're dealing with, eventually you'll find that underneath is a false god. Until that god is dethroned, and the Lord God takes his rightful place, you will not have victory ... Idolatry isn't an issue; it is the issue." **Kyle Idleman**

Split allegiances. Feet in 2 worlds. A God-substitute.

Sin isn't only doing bad things, it is more fundamentally making good things into ultimate things. Sin is building your life and meaning on anything, even a very good thing, more than on God. Whatever we build our life on will drive us and enslave us. Sin is primarily idolatry. **Tim Keller**

Idols: wood/stone images, statues

gods of the past

gods of **present**

Why would you trust, focus on an idol?

"These people come near to me with their mouth and <u>honor me</u> with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." **Isaiah 29:13**

²³ "Now then," said Joshua, "<u>throw away the foreign gods that</u> <u>are among you and yield your hearts to the LORD</u>, the God of Israel." Joshua 24:23

2 THINGS GOD IS CHALLENGING US WITH TODAY:

1. THROW AWAY your idols. What is an idol?

What's given more consideration, concern & attention than God for you?

What in your life replaces/competes with God? What drives/enslaves us?

Wherever you go for comfort when you are hurt, down, broken?

You know something is an idol to you by how you feel-react when it's taken from you, or the threat of having it removed.

Why do we lean toward trusting idols?

SOME IDOLS: Success. reputation, wealth, money, stuff (guitars, cars, guns, tv, watches) being ripped, body-image, fitness, work, children, girlfriend, wife, sexuality, porn, security, retirement, leisure, comfort, shopping, gaming, technology, bottle-needle-snort, power-control, sports, fantasy

Idols of the past: family reputation; success, pride, proving someone wrong, something God gave you (gifts, call, etc.)

2. <u>YIELD</u> your hearts to the Lord.

Yield... lit, bend... surrender your heart fully to him.

3. **CHOOSE: Desire** is not enough. **Decision** and **Determination** must accompany it.
