## "But Now" The Innermost Meaning of the Cross

## I. "But now..."

Romans 3:21 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—

Righteousness isn't what you do; it's who you are!

## II. How do you get it?

Romans 3:22-24 ...the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

Four aspects of faith...

1. Faith that centers on the *person* of Christ

Romans 3:22 ...the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ...

- 2. It's "all who believe" who are saved; it's not automatically and universally applied.
- 3. We are made righteous "by his grace as a gift."

**Romans 3:23-24** ...for all have sinned... and are justified by his grace **as a gift**...

4. Christ redeems us.

Romans 3:24 ...and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

III. The Innermost meaning of the cross.

The How...

Romans 3:23-25a All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, [24] and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, [25] whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith.

The Why...

Romans 3:25b-26 This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. [26] It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
