BIG IDEA: God invites you into relationship with himself through Jesus... into a conversation.

"this is the real and eternal life: That they know you, the one and only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you sent."

John 17:3 Message

"I will give them <u>a heart to know me</u>, that I am the LORD. They will be my people, and I will be their God, for they will return to me with all their heart." **Jeremiah 24:7** (31:33-34)

"If you <u>really know me</u>, you will know my Father as well." **John 14:7**

"I want you to show love, not offer sacrifices. <u>I want you to know me</u> more than I want burnt offerings." **Hosea 6:6** NLT

- --You must be introduced.
- --Knowing him means coming to him on his terms.
- --You begin the great conversation... Prayer!

Prayer is...

- 1) Asking, requests, expressing our wants.
- 2) Expressing feelings to God, unburdening, confessing.
- 3) Reflection on truths about God with God.
- 4) Claiming promises God has made.
- 5) Turning God's truth over and over in our minds. (meditation)
- 6) Yielding ourselves to Him in trusting surrender.
- 7) Conversing with God.

HOW MIGHT YOU DETECT GOD COMMUNICATING?

- God speaking through his Word.
- Lectio Divina—slowly reading Scripture with God.
- Still small voice.
- Conscience nudge.
- Promptings by the Spirit
- Conversations with others
- Nature
- Sermons and small group Bible studies
- Impressions
- Visuals

NOTE 1: 99.9% is Clark Kent, .1% Superman.

NOTE 2: The sacred and the secular.

WHAT MIGHT JESUS SOUND LIKE?

He'll ask you questions. (Mk. 8:27-29; John 6:67; Mt. 14:31)

He'll call you to believe and step out in that belief. I'd call this: Faith-filled, loving, relational obedience. (Mt. 14:28)

He'll call you to follow him, & his ways. (Mt. 4:19; 6:1ff; 9:9)

He'll talk to you about what's inside you. (Mt. 12:34; Lk. 6:45)

He'll tell you he loves you, and affirm you. (Jn. 15:15; 21:5)

He'll help you know when you are sinning, grieving him, and need to turn around. (Jn. 16:8; 5:14; 8:11)

He'll prompt you to serve others, share with them, live generously. (Jn. 13:1-17; Lk. 6:38)

He'll tell you to slow down. (Lk. 10:38-42; Jn. 8:6-8; Mk. 4:39)

Do you know him? His hand is extended to you right now.
