BIG IDEA: As we come into continual, intimate contact with Jesus, God's provision & creative power break into our lives.

1. Times of crisis **NEVER SURPRISE** Jesus!

No crisis happens where Jesus is not there.

⁷ Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!"

Are we going to look at things from a human point of view, of from God's view? (2 Cor. 5:16; Josh. 6:1-2)

Bring what you have to Jesus.

Jesus is the Lord of more than enough. (John 10:10)

2. The One who God sent, who calls you to believe, and follow him, has the creative <u>POWER TO PROVIDE</u>.

2 Kings 4:42-44 Elisha, 20 barley loaves & 100 fed. Moses & manna (Ex. 16)

Messiah and Prophet (Dt. 18:15-18)

¹⁴ After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." ¹⁵ Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself.

In Jesus, God is replacing all they've trusted in.

By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. ¹⁸ A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. ¹⁹ When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were frightened. ²⁰ But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." ²¹ Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading. **John 6:1–21**

3. The One who God sent, the One who calls you to believe and follow him, can <u>WALK ON WATER</u>, and defy the normal laws of nature!

⁴ The Jewish Passover Festival was near.

⁵ When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" ⁶ He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do.

⁸ Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, ⁹ "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"

¹¹ Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

¹² When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." ¹³ So they gathered them and filled twelve
