"I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.' **Acts 13:22** (1 Sam. 13:14; Jer. 3:15; Acts 7:45-46)

BIG IDEA: What does it mean to be a person "after God's own heart?"

Why is this important? <u>Because this is the relationship</u> that you have been restored to in Christ!

"Blessed is the one in whose spirit is no deceit." Ps. 32:2

"whose lives are lived in complete honesty!" 32:2 NLT

"you're holding nothing back from him." 32:2 MESSAGE

Being a person after God's heart means <u>HOLDING</u> <u>NOTHING BACK</u>. Living in <u>COMPLETE HONESTY</u> with him.

"When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.

For day and night your hand was heavy on me;

my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer.

- Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity.
- I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD." And you forgave the guilt of my sin. **Psalm 32:3-5**

Adam and Eve hid from God. (Gen. 3:8-11)

Peter held nothing back. (Lk. 5:8; Mt. 16:15-23; Jn. 6:68-69)

Vertically AND Horizontally

"Anybody who does wrong hates the light and keeps away from it, for fear his deeds may be exposed." **John 3:20**
