BIG IDEA: Observe how Mary parented Jesus, and glean from her how we can be better mothers, fathers, mentors and friends.

Mary. Mother of Jesus.

1. She saw herself as **GOD'S SERVANT** as a parent.

"I am the Lord's servant. May your word to me be fulfilled." **Luke 1:38**

"Work at everything you do with all your heart. Work as if you were working for the Lord... You are serving the Lord Christ." **Colossians 3:23-24** NIrV (Mt. 25:40)

2. She saw her child as God's gift FOR OTHERS.
