THE ANTIDOTE FOR DYING

December 31, 2017 John 8:21-30 by Bob Branch Finding Jesus, Finding Life, part 26

BIG IDEA: Jesus himself is the antidote to "dying *in* our sins" by dying *for* our sins and revealing the Father's love to us through it.

- ²¹ Once more Jesus said to them, "I am going away, and you will look for me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come."
- ²² This made the Jews ask, "Will he kill himself? Is that why he says, 'Where I go, you cannot come'?"
- ²³ But he continued, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. ²⁴ I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am he, you will indeed die in your sins."

1. When we trust Jesus to save us, we <u>CHANGE</u> CITIZENSHIP.

"Our citizenship is in heaven." Philippians 3:20

"They are not of the world, even as I am not of it." **John 17:16** (15:19)

"Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things." Colossians 3:1-2

2. To die in our sins means to NOT GO where he's going.

²⁵ "Who are you?" they asked.

"Just what I have been telling you from the beginning," Jesus replied. ²⁶ "I have much to say in judgment of you. But he who sent me is trustworthy, and what I have heard from him I tell the world." ²⁷ They did not understand that he was telling them about his Father.

"This is eternal life, to know you, the only true God, and him whom you have sent - Jesus Christ." John 17:3 JBP

"I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them." **John 17:26**

3. Just as Jesus' relationship with his Father defines him, so too <u>OUR RELATIONSHIP</u> with the Father—paid for and given to us by Jesus—defines us!

²⁸ So Jesus said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he and that I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me. ²⁹ The one who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases him." ³⁰ Even as he spoke, many believed in him.

"And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." **John 12:32** (3:14)

4. The death of Jesus on the cross will reveal God's justice and love, our helplessness in our sin, and Jesus' identity as the MESSIAH-DELIVERER.

"Christ died for sins once and for all time. The One who did what is right died for those who don't do right. He died to bring you to God." **1 Peter 3:18** NIrV
