THE TRUTH AND THE FREEDOM EFFECT

January 7, 2018 John 8:31-37 by Bob Branch Finding Jesus, Finding Life, part 27

BIG IDEA: Jesus calls us into a master-follower relationship with him, which yields successively deeper levels of freedom as we invest in it.

Believing in Jesus establishes a relationship with him is the way in. Abiding in him and his Word as his followers is the way on.

³¹ To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. ³² Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

³³ They answered him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never been slaves of anyone. How can you say that we shall be set free?"

³⁴ Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. ³⁵ Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. ³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. ³⁷ I know that you are Abraham's descendants. Yet you are looking for a way to kill me, because you have no room for my word. **John 8:31-37**

Sin is hamartia

- **Tragic flaw,** can't be overcome.
- Missing the mark, falling short.

"For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard." **Romans 3:23** NLT

• **Rebellion** at our core "original sin".

"Jews and Gentiles alike are all <u>under the power of sin</u>." Romans 3:9

- Weakness of our flesh (Col. 2:13; Rom. 7:5)
- Sin Personified "you were slaves to sin" Romans 6:20

³¹ "If you abide in my word, you are really my disciples. ³² Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

- **1.** To abide means to <u>LIVE IN IT</u>.
- 2. A disciple is a LEARNER and COMMITTED FOLLOWER.
- **3.** Jesus' Truth means <u>HOW GOD SEES THINGS</u> and wants us to respond to it.
- 4. Jesus invites us to know his Truth <u>BY EXPERIENCE</u>.
- 5. Jesus invites us into freedom from the <u>ENTANGLEMENTS</u>, <u>LIES</u> and bondage of sin and its grip on this world.
