"What are *you* known for? What are *we* known for?"

**BIG IDEA: Jesus wants to put us on display to a sin-sick world, to draw people to himself. Loving each other the way he loved us is supposed to be the primary thing we are known for.**

"Let me give you a new command: Love one another. In the same way I loved you, you love one another. This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples—when they see the love you have for each other." **John 13:34-35** Message

1. Not a **REQUEST**, a **COMMAND** to love.

2. More than a feeling—it is **SELF-GIVING** love—which includes our feelings, but more!

*eros, philia, storge, agape*

3. Our love is to be a **JESUS-SHAPED** love—modeled on the way he loved us!

- Love moves toward others. (John 1:1-14)
- Love doesn't hold onto rights. (Phil. 2:5-11)
- Love accepts and meets us where we are. (John 4; Mt. 8:2; Lk. 15:1ff)
- Love is merciful and honest. (Mark 10:21)

- Love makes forgiveness real. (Mark 2:1-12)
- Love brings light. (John 1:5, 9-15)
- Love endures. (Mt. 17:17; Mk. 16:14)
- Love touches. (Mt. 8:1-3; 9:21; 19:13-15)
- Love is open, inviting. (Mt. 4:19-20; Jn. 1:43)
- Love is generous and meets needs. (Lk. 7:22)
- Love empathizes. (John 11:33, 35, 38)
- Love lifts the oppressed. (Jn. 4; 11:5; Lk. 10:38f; Mt. 28:5f)
- Love does not react. (Mt. 26:63).
- Love serves. (Jn. 13:1-17; Mt. 20:28)
- Love dies. And, beautifully, because it does, Love lives.

"My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." **John 15:12-13**

"We love because he first loved us." **1 John 4:19**

"Love one another with brotherly affection." **Romans 12:10** ESV

"Love each other deeply with all your heart." **1 Peter 1:22** NLT
