BIG IDEA: God wants to change the way we think about ourselves and our resources, so we can joyfully participate in his good and generous purposes. This generosity is an essential part of being a disciple of Jesus, not an option.

<sup>6</sup> "Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

The Law of the Harvest (Sowing and Reaping)

1. We sow money and resources by giving, and the <u>HARVEST</u> comes according to what and how much is sown. It is a cause-and-effect relationship. Give a lot (of what you have), and harvest a lot! (Prov. 11:25)

2. To God, our giving <u>ATTITUDE</u> is as important as the gift itself. Joyous giving is part of being in God's good and generous family.

3. Trusting that "GOD IS ABLE" to bless us and provide for us is intended to fuel our giving.

4. God's provides resources, so we can <u>SHARE</u> them. When we give, God will see to it that we have enough—even more than enough—to continue the circle of blessing.
