What does God really want?

BIG IDEA: "Because real, full and eternal life comes from me, your connection *to* me-*with* me is the key to everything that really matters."

Prune, Abide, Depend. Ask, Bear Fruit.

¹ "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener.

"Israel is the vineyard of the Lord." Isaiah 5:7

¹ "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ² He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ³ You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you.

¹ God's <u>PRUNING</u> is normal and necessary, even for faithful Christians!

"You've got everything doctrinally right, but your heart left a while ago. Return to me, or..." **Revelation 2:2-4**

⁴ Abide in me, as I also abide in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must abide in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you abide in me.

² Branches produce fruit because they Abide, they "stay <u>CONNCECTED</u> to me."

Abide: the verb form of *dwelling place*—home!

⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you abide in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

³ Jesus calls us to connect, <u>DEPEND</u> and trust him with everything.

⁶ If you do not abide in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you abide in me and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

⁴ Answered prayer is the outcome of living <u>IN SYNC</u> with Jesus.

⁵ You were <u>BORN</u> to bear fruit that will last!

"The Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." **Galatians 5:22-23** NLT
