### LOVING WELL

June 17, 2018 John 15:9-17 by Bob Branch Finding Jesus, Finding Life part 44

BIG IDEA: Abiding in Jesus' love and loving well will ignite a life of purpose, impact and answered prayer.

<sup>9</sup> "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now abide in my love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep my commands, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and abide in his love. <sup>12</sup> My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you.

1. "My command to you is love as <u>I HAVE LOVED YOU</u> and make this your home base."

#### How have you been loved by Jesus?

### 2. "Joy will flow from your connected, <u>GENEROUSLY</u> <u>LOVING</u> life."

<sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. <sup>14</sup> You are my friends if you do what I command. <sup>15</sup> I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know what his master is doing. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I heard from my Father I have made known to you.

# 3. "My self-giving, other-oriented love graduates into mutually-sharing <u>FRIENDSHIP</u>."

"I no longer call you servants, as servants don't know what their master's doing. Instead, I call you friends, for everything that I heard from my Father I given you." John 15:15

<sup>16</sup> You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that abides—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. <sup>17</sup> This is my command: Love each other.

# 4. "As my abiding friend, I have *called* you and *built* you for lasting impact through <u>LOVING</u> well and <u>ASKING</u> boldly."
