EPIC FAIL, Part 1 September 7, 2018 John 18:15-27 By Bob Branch Experiencing The Passion of Jesus, part 2

Have you ever experienced an epic fail?

BIG IDEA: Peter's epic fail reveals God & us in a unique way. It reveals:

1. What God endures for loving us. He SUFFERS LONG.

"He came to his own, and <u>his own people did not</u> receive him." John 1:11 ESV

"Light has come into the world, but <u>people loved</u> <u>darkness instead of light</u>" **John 3:19**

"Love suffers long." **1 Corinthians 13:4** NKJV

2. He's near to us in our pain. He EMPATHIZES.

"For we do not have a high priest <u>who is not able to</u> <u>sympathize with our weaknesses</u>, but who has been <u>tempted in all things in the same way, without sin</u>. Therefore, let us approach with confidence to the throne of grace, in order that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. **Heb. 4:15-16**

A man with leprosy came and knelt in front of Jesus, begging to be healed. "If you are willing, you can heal me and make me clean," he said. <u>Moved with</u> <u>compassion</u>, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!" **Mark 1:40-41** NLT

3. He knows we will fail him and does not give up on us. He knows and <u>BELIEVES</u>.

"Where I am going, you cannot follow now, but you will follow later." Peter asked, "Lord, why can't I follow you now? <u>I will lay down my life for you</u>." Then Jesus answered, "Will you really lay down your life for me? Very truly I tell you, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times! **Jn. 13:36-38**

4. Our epic fails do not define us. We have HOPE.

"Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail. And <u>when you have turned back</u>, strengthen your brothers." **Luke 22:31-32**

5. Peter's epic fail teaches us. We LEARN.

"They <u>loved not their lives</u>, even unto death." **Revelation 12:11** ESV
