THE KING WAS HANGING THERE

November 4, 2018 John 19:17-22 by Bob Branch Experiencing the Passion of Jesus, part 6

BIG IDEA: Jesus was sent to a criminal's death, yet even there he is still revealed as king. The King is hanging there, and God is working through it all.

¹⁷ Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). There they crucified him, and with him two others—one on each side and Jesus in the middle.

1. This is being done TO GOD. God is experiencing this.

2. In all this cruelty, Jesus is TAKING ALL THE SIN of all of us for all of time into himself.
