BIG IDEA: How do people change? How does God change us?

¹ Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

1. Live <u>RESPONSIVELY</u>—like you've received mercy.

(Col. 3:23-24; Mt. 6:1-18)

² Do not be conformed to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. RECOGNIZE the world and the Lord's influence on you.

"we are not unaware of his schemes." 2 Cor. 2:11

"we are God's masterpiece." Ephesians 2:10 NLT

Transform—*metamorphesthe*—metamorphosis.
