Psalm 34:1-8

BIG IDEA: Even though the Christian life is a faith-walk, God invites us to encounter him with our senses, which builds our faith and beckons us to come under his care. Taste and See.

“Taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.” **Psalm 34:8**

1. God invites us to EXPERIENCE him with our senses.

- Through Creation. (Rom. 1:20)
- Through Communion. (John 6:55)
- Through Singing Worship (Psalm 22:3 KJV)
- Through Daily Time with Him. (Psalm 46:10; John 17:3)

2. We encounter God's GOODNESS.

“Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!” **Matthew 7:9-11**

3. We can draw near to him, under his CARE and PROTECTION.
