POWER WITH PURPOSE

June 9, 2019 Acts 1:1–2:21 by Bob Branch God's Spirit At Work, part 2 of 2

BIG IDEA: God promised his Spirit would come and make us alive—indwelling and empowering us to do his bidding on the earth. We can and should expect him to continue this work *in*, *on* and *through* us.

⁴ "wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. ⁵ For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

1. There is <u>MORE</u>—and we should wait for and expect it.

⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

2. The Spirit COMES WITH POWER.

3. The Power is for a <u>PURPOSE</u>—telling others about Jesus.

^{2:2} Suddenly a **sound** like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and **filled** the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of **fire** that separated and came to **rest** on each of them. ⁴ All of them were **filled** with the Holy Spirit and began to **speak** in other tongues as the Spirit **enabled** them.

4. The Spirit <u>FILLED</u> them. (Ex. 3:2)

3 dimensions of "tongues"

"I live here!"

⁵ Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. ⁶ When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken. ⁷ Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans? ⁸ Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language?... ¹¹ we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" ¹² Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"

5. It came with OTHERWORLDLY PHENOMENA. (Acts 4:31)

6. The Spirit brought WORSHIP!

¹³ made fun of them... "They have had too much wine."

7. There are always many <u>REACTIONS</u> to it.

¹⁴ "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. ¹⁵ These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! ¹⁶ No, **this is that** which was spoken by the prophet Joel: ¹⁷ " 'In the last days, God says, I will *pour out my Spirit on all people*. Your sons and daughters will *prophesy*, your young men will see *visions*, your old men will dream *dreams*. [revelation] ¹⁸ Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will *prophesy*. ¹⁹ I will show *wonders* in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke. ²⁰ The sun will be turned to darkness and the *moon* to blood before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord. ²¹ And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'
