BIG IDEA: How we can find God's joy and enter into it in any season.

Joy, n. joi, settled sense of gladness, delight & pleasure.

1. God's kind of joy is experienced <u>IN COMMUNITY</u> with others.

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." John 13:34

- 2. God's Joy is enjoyed in SHARING A MEAL together.
- 3. God's joy is <u>SIMPLE</u>.
