re-sil-ient, /rəˈzilyənt/ adj., able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions; able to recoil or spring back into shape after bending, stretching, or being compressed.

"The Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." **Acts 2:47**

"a wide door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many adversaries." **1 Corinthians 16:9** ESV

BIG IDEA: Because <u>God himself is always working</u>, you, the church and God's purposes will continue to thrive even under opposition, hostility and hardship.

- 1. Things grow because of God's <u>ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT</u>.
- ¹ You.
 "it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure." Philippians 2:13 ESV
- ² His family, the church—the community of faith.
 "we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ... as each part does its work." Ephesians 4:15-16
- ³ His larger purposes of setting things right throughout the world.

"God was <u>reconciling the world to himself in Christ</u>... and he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore <u>Christ's ambassadors</u>, as though God were making his appeal through us." **2 Cor. 5:19-20**

2. God's growth **STRENGTHENS** under hostility & pressure.

"In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." **John 16:33**

"They did what your power and will had decided beforehand should happen. Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken.
