WHEN THE PRESSURE IS ONE

March 22, 2020 Hebrews 10:19-25 By Bob Branch How Shall We Then Live, part 2

BIG IDEA: What to do when the pressure is on (since God has done the heavy lifting already).

The overall idea is Jesus is superior in every way to every dimension of their old Jewish faith.

Here's what to do when the pressure is on!

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² **let us draw near to God** with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ **Let us hold unswervingly to the hope** we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And **let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds**, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 10:19-25

3 invitations—all "let us" NOT "you should"

What do you turn to when you are squeezed?

1. Let us DRAW NEAR to God.

All obstacles to God have been removed by and in Jesus.

"Welcome! Come near me. All obstacles are not removed. Come!"

Spiritual disciplines: Finding God in the Scriptures. Praying and asking. Worshipping, praising, thanking; Communing with God.

When have you sensed God's nearness?

2. Let us <u>HOLD UNSWERVINGLY</u> to our Hope.

Our future hope anchors us in the turmoil of the present.

The book of **Revelation**—a portrait of hope.

3. Let us SPUR ONE ANOTHER to love and good deeds.
