What contaminates you?

BIG IDEA: Part ways with what drains God's life from us and feed what builds it.

¹¹ We have spoken freely to you... opened wide our hearts to you. We are not withholding our affection from you, but you are withholding yours from us. As a fair exchange... open wide your hearts also.

¹⁴ Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? ¹⁵ What harmony is there between Christ and Belial? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever? ¹⁶ What agreement is there between the <u>temple of God</u> and <u>idols</u>? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said:

"I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people." Ezk 37:26

¹⁷ Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." Is 52:11

¹⁸ And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." ^{2 Sam 7:14}
