BIG IDEA: Your giving is an investment in God's life in you (and the world), which yields great returns—both now and in eternity.

⁶ Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. [INVESTMENT] ⁷ Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
[ATTITUDE] ⁸ And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. [MORE THAN ENOUGH]

⁹As it is written: "They have freely scattered their gifts to the poor; their righteousness endures forever." [ROI: ETERNAL PAYBACK]
