September 13, 2020 2 Corinthians 10:1-11 by Bob Branch Real Faith in Raw Times, Part 17

BIG IDEA: Since our thoughts direct our lives, managing your thinking with God will be paramount.

OPPONNENTS: About Jesus. About Themselves. About Paul.

¹ Now I, Paul, myself, appeal to you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ—I who am humble among you in person but bold toward you when absent. [UPSIDE-DOWN JESUS-WAY] ² I beg you that when I am present I will not need to be bold with the confidence by which I plan to challenge certain people who think we are living according to the flesh. ³ For although we live in the flesh, we do not wage war according to the flesh, ⁴ since the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but are powerful through God for the demolition of strongholds. [BATTLEFIELD OF IDEAS] We demolish arguments ⁵ and every proud thing that is raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ. ⁶ And we are ready to punish any disobedience, once your obedience is complete. [BATTLE STRATEGIES]

⁷ Look at what is obvious. If anyone is confident that he belongs to Christ, let him remind himself of this: Just as he belongs to Christ, so do we. ⁸ For if I boast a little too much about our authority, which the Lord gave for building you up and not for tearing you down, I will not be put to shame. [UPSIDE DOWN AUTHORITY] ⁹ I don't want to seem as though I am trying to terrify you with my letters. ¹⁰ For it is said, "His letters are weighty and powerful, but his physical presence is weak and his public speaking amounts to nothing." ¹¹ Let such a person consider this: What we are in our letters, when we are absent, we will also be in our actions when we are present.
