POWER IN WEAKNESS October 11, 2020 2 Corinthians 12:1-10 by Bob Branch Real Faith in Raw Times, part 20

BIG IDEA: Your power-in-weakness connection is the conduit for God's resurrection power in and through you.

¹ I must go on boasting. Although there is nothing to be gained, I will go on to visions and revelations from the Lord. ² I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know—God knows. ³ And I know that this man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows—⁴ was caught up to paradise and heard inexpressible things, things that no one is permitted to tell. [**EXPERIENCES**] ⁵ I will boast about a man like that, but I will not boast about myself, except <u>about my weaknesses</u>. ⁶ Even if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so no one will think more of me than is warranted by what I do or say, ⁷ or because of these surpassingly great revelations. [**REALISTIC**]

Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. ⁸ Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. [**GOD SAID**, "NO."] ⁹ But he said to me, "<u>My</u> <u>grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in</u> <u>weakness</u>." [**ENOUGH**] Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. ¹⁰ That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. [**LEAN**] **2 Corinthians 12:1-10**
