- His way is easy, light-handed, GRACIOUS. (Mt. 9:20, Luke 10:41)
- He invited people into his inner circle—NEARNESS. (Lk. 5:8-11, John 13:23)
- His door was always OPEN. (Lk. 7:37; 19:2)
- He initiated & TOUCHED people. (Mt. 8:3, 19:13-15)
- He SERVED food and washed feet—went low and preferred others. (John 13; 21:9)
- He SACRIFICED himself to ransom us. (1 Jn 4:10; John 15:13)
