## BIG IDEA: Loving like Jesus is the "advanced-level" and changes the entire way we do life.

<sup>9</sup> And this is my prayer: <u>that your love may abound more</u> <u>and more</u> in knowledge and depth of insight...

<sup>27</sup> Whatever happens, [as citizens of heaven] <u>conduct</u> <u>yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ.</u> Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the <u>one Spirit</u>, <u>striving together as one</u> for the faith of the gospel

<sup>1</sup> Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <sup>2</sup> then make my joy complete by being likeminded, having the <u>same love</u>, being one in spirit and of one mind. <sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.
