What is a Disciple, part 2 of 3

DISCIPLE, *n.* di-'sī-pəl; a follower/student of a teacher, leader, or philosopher; pupil/adherent of their doctrines

“A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is fully trained will be like his teacher.” **Luke 6:40**

“For those he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son” **Romans 8:29**

“Don’t copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God’s will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.” **Rom. 12:2**

2. **We are formed as we invest in _____
—*Know the God the Scriptures reveal.***

“You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life. But the Scriptures point to me! Yet you refuse to come to me to receive this life.” **Jn 5:39-40** NLT

“These are written down so you will believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and in the act of believing, have real and eternal life in the way he personally revealed it.” **John 20:31** TM
