## **ReSET: Worship God**

January 10, 2021 Psalm 103; Rev. 5 by Bob Branch

What is "worship"?

**BIG IDEA: Intentionally worshipping God resets our souls to him—his perspectives and priorities.** Is that why? No. It is a consistent by-product.

**Worship**, *v*. intentionally expressing extravagant love, honor, praise, reverence and submission to God because he is worthy of it.

"Lift up your hands in the holy place and bless the LORD!" **Psalm 134:2** CSB

"No one is to appear before me empty-handed." **Exodus 23:15** 

**1.** Worship intentionally \_\_\_\_\_\_ you to God. *It is not about you. It's about him.* 

"My soul, bless the LORD, and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

My soul, bless the LORD, and do not forget all his benefits..." **Psalm 103:1-2** CSB

2. Worship \_\_\_\_\_\_ you to Who God Is—and the Way Things Truly Are.

Revelation 4:2-6, 5:11-14
