BIG QUESTION: What are the consequences when we do not forgive?

2 Samuel 6 Highlights:

- ³ They set the ark of God on a new cart
- $^{\rm 5}$ David ...celebrating with all their might before the Lord
- ⁷ The Lord's anger burned against Uzzah because of <u>his</u> <u>irreverent act</u>; therefore God struck him down, and <u>he died</u> <u>there</u> beside the ark of God.
- ¹² David went to bring up the ark of God
- ¹⁴ Wearing a linen ephod, David was dancing before the Lord with all his might
- ¹⁶ Michal daughter of Saul watched from a window. And when she saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord, **she despised him in her heart**.
- ²⁰ Michal: "How the king of Israel has distinguished himself today, going around half-naked in full view of the slave girls of his servants as any vulgar fellow would!"
- ²¹ David said to Michal, "It was before the Lord, who chose me rather than your father or anyone from his house when he appointed me ruler over the Lord's people Israel—I will celebrate before the Lord. ²² I will become even more undignified than this, and I will be humiliated in my own eyes. But by these slave girls you spoke of, I will be held in honor."
- ²³ And <u>Michal daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death</u>. 2 Samuel 6:1-23
