LIVING BEYOND YOUR FEARS

BIG IDEA: Focusing on something greater than your fear is key to overcoming it.

²⁷ Just one thing: As citizens of heaven, live your life worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or am absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one Spirit, in one accord, contending together for the faith of the gospel, ²⁸ not being frightened in any way by your opponents. This is a sign of destruction for them, but of your salvation—and this is from God. ²⁹ For it has been granted to you on Christ's behalf not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him, ³⁰ since you are engaged in the same struggle that you saw I had & now hear that I have. **Phil. 1:27-30** CSB

- Standing together in submission to God's Spirit (John 8:1-11; 1 Cor. 12:13)
- Seeking and maintaining authentic unity/oneness.

"I pray for them all to be joined together as one even as you and I, Father, are joined together as one. I pray for them to become one with us so that the world will recognize that you sent me. ²² For the very glory you have given to me I have given them so that they will be joined together as one and experience the same unity that we enjoy. ²³ You live fully in me and now I live fully in them so that they will experience perfect unity, and the world will be convinced that you have sent me, for they will see that you love each one of them with the same passionate love that you have for me." **John 17:21-23** TPT (Rom. 12:18)
