FINDING RELIEF IN STRESSFUL TIMES

March 20, 2022 Philippians 4:4-7 by Allan Jimenez

BIG IDEA: Relief comes to all of us by keeping God at the epicenter of our stressful times (storms).

⁴Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! ⁵Let your gentleness be evident to all. <u>The Lord is near</u>. ⁶Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:4-7** NIV

1 - Because He is Near, we can choose to REJOICE!

Be cheerful with joyous celebration in every season of life. Let your joy overflow! **Philippians 4:4** TPT

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. **Romans 12:12** NIV

¹⁶ Always be joyful. ¹⁷ Never stop praying. ¹⁸ Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18** NLT

2 - Because He is Near, we can choose to be GENTLE!

¹² Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. **Colossians 3:12-13** NIV

3 - Because He is Near, we can choose to turn our worries into PRAYERS!

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, **he hears us**. **1 John 5:14** NIV

The righteous cry out, and the <u>LORD hears them</u>; he delivers them from all their troubles. **Psalm 34:17** NIV

<u>The Lord is near</u> to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. **Psalm 145:18** NIV

4- Because He is Near, we can abide in his PEACE!

(Joy + Gentleness + Prayer + Petition) x Thanksgiving = **The Peace of God**

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. **John 14:27** NIV

And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.

Colossians 3:15 NLT

Remember:

God's nearness causes us to rejoice, his nearness affects our gentleness; his nearness dispels anxiety, and nearness brings peace.
