BIG IDEA: God's Spirit will bring holy discomfort when we chose directions or activities that stray from God's good and loving best for us. Repentance is the adjustment back on the path.

⁷ Nevertheless, I am telling you the truth. It is for your benefit that I go away, because if I don't go away the *Counselor* will not come to you. If I go, I will send him to you. ⁸ When he comes, he will convict the world about sin, righteousness, and judgment: ⁹ About sin, because they do not believe in me; ¹⁰ about righteousness, because I am going to the Father and you will no longer see me; ¹¹ and about judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged." **John 16:7-11** CSB

The Spirit brings the convincing argument!

- 1) Prove the "world" is wrong about him and have sinned because they did not believe he is the One God sent, the Messiah, the true king. (Acts 9)
- 2) Prove that Jesus was <u>right</u> about everything and is <u>setting things right</u> thru everything he did.
- 3) Prove the "ruler of this world," the devil, behind everything moving away from God—has been judged, condemned, and stripped of authority. (1 Jn. 3:8)
- 1. The Spirit makes us _____ with sin— speaking into everything that moves us away from God.
