4. The Spirit _____ thru praying/singing in tongues.

3 modes of tongues:

- 1) Unknown to speaker, known to hearers. (Acts 2)
- 2) Unknown to speaker, needs interpreting. (1 Cor. 14)
- 3) "Personal prayer language" useful for praying/praising.

"For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit... Anyone who speaks in a tongue edifies themselves, but the one who prophesies edifies the church. I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be edified." 1 Corinthians 14:2, 4-5

"For <u>if I pray in a tongue</u>, <u>my spirit prays</u>, <u>but my mind is unfruitful</u>. So what shall I do? <u>I will pray with my spirit</u>, <u>but I will also pray with my understanding</u>; <u>I will sing with my spirit</u>, <u>but I will also sing with my understanding</u>... You are <u>giving thanks</u> well enough, but no one else is edified." **1 Corinthians 14:14-15, 17**
