### **Key Elements**

### 1. Why did Elijah do that? (1 Kings 18:20-35)

- a. Elijah challenges 450 false prophets [22]
- b. Elijah repaired the altar of the Lord [32]
- c. Elijah requested to pour wafer on offering and on the wood [33]

# 2. How did Elijah have such faith and courage (1 Kings 17:1-24)

The cycle of **TOE**:

- a. Trust in the words of God
- b. Obey the words of God
- c. Experience the words and provisions of God
- d. ... repeat ...

### 3. Elijah served God and experience victory in God

- a. People turned to God
- b. Truth revealed
- c. Hope of nation restored

### 4. Take aways from Elijah's event

- a. Rely on God & His power as source of strength when serving God
- b. Run toward God's Will as direction of ministry when serving God
- c. Rejoice in God glorified as purpose of ministry when serving God
